Notification

Subject: Regarding sanction of new M.B. A, course at **Sindhi Institute of Management**, during the academic year 2018-19.

Reference: 1) Government letter number: ED 164 UBV 2018 Dated 07-08-2018.

2) Vice Chancellors order dated:

As per provision 17, under section 59 of Karnataka State Universities Act 2008, as empowered under section 7 of amended Act 2015, **Bangalore Central University**, has sanctioned permission to start M.B.A, programme at Sindhi Seva Samithi's , Sindhi Institute of Management, from the year 2018-19, subject to the following conditions of affiliation.

Conditions:

1. The grant in aid is not applicable for the above mentioned new course and it will be considered as permanently unaided course.
2. The college is strictly abide by the existing Government Orders and university guidelines, and its provisions.
3. Student strength shall not be increased without the permission of the University for the Above Mentioned New Course.
4. The college shall strictly comply with all the conditions put forth by Local Inquiry Committee and college shall report to the University in 15 days having complied with these conditions.
5. The college shall strictly comply with the Government Orders regarding reservation quotas while admitting students for the above course.



6. The college shall not collect any capitation fee.
7. As per the Supreme Court Verdict Dated: 13-08-1997 in the case of Vaishaka Vs State Government of Rajasthan , any person creating riots at the college or office, working place or any male student sexually harassing a female student/women is a punishable offence. Any student or person indulging in such activities can be dismissed from the job/ debarred. The college shall appoint a committee to control such activities and take necessary actions.
8. The college shall not keep the marks cards and other documents of students for more than six months without any valid reasons. College shall return all the marks cards and other documents to the students after the admission approval and report the same to the University.
9. The college shall take necessary actions to enhance the academic standards of the courses offered and education system. The management/principal shall treat the students and the teachers in service with compassion and harmony.
10. The college shall strictly follow the roster system in the admission process.
11. The college shall issue transfer certificate to the students whenever they request, without any hassle. In such a case the college shall not collect any other fees except the tuition fee of the academic year remaining semester.
12. The college shall take necessary actions to enhance the academic standards of the courses offered and education system. The management/principal shall treat the students and the teachers in service with compassion and harmony.
13. The college shall compulsorily use Kannada in its administrative activities.
14. Application for the renewal of courses for the academic year 2019-20 shall be made to the Bengaluru Central University.
15. The principal of the college shall submit the list of all eligible teachers for the purpose of evaluation to the chairman of board of examiners and compulsorily depute them for the valuation work, failing which the affiliation will be cancelled.
16. The college shall follow the university orders issued from time-to-time as applicable to students, teaching and non-teaching staffs. The college shall admit the students not exceeding the above mentioned permitted number and based on the eligibility criteria mentioned in the university notification. In case, the number of students admitted exceeds the permitted number the affiliation stands cancelled.
17. The college shall not keep the marks cards and other documents of students for more than six months without any valid reasons. College shall return all the marks cards and other documents to the students after the admission approval and report the same to the University.
18. The notification of Bengaluru Central University shall apply after the seat matrix of MBA/ MCA courses published in the website of Karnataka Examinations Authority.
19. College shall obtain extended approval from AICTE every academic year.
20. The college shall comply with the orders issued/ to be issued by AICTE, New Delhi, Government of Karnataka and Bengaluru Central University.
21. Admission of students to the MBA and MCA courses shall be made in accordance with the applicable norms.



22. The college shall admit 50% of prescribed seats **as allotted by University** under Government quota **and shall not collect the admission and other fees in excess of the** prescribed amount as per University orders.
